Members may enroll in services by calling 1-866-202-4014 and following the prompts. Once enrolled, Walgreens will coordinate delivery. Physicians may also call or fax prescriptions to 1-800-334-5504. Walgreens Specialty Pharmacy hours of operation are Monday through Friday 9am – 10pm PST.
