

Your Medicare Part D plan is changing for 2019

This fall, look for information on your new Medicare prescription drug plan called VibrantRx (PDP). The same staff that supports your current plan will continue to support the new plan. Here's what to expect:

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In early October, you will receive a termination letter from the current drug plan. You don't need to do anything. **You will be automatically enrolled in VibrantRx.**

Since this is a new plan, you will not get an Annual Notice of Changes (ANOC) this year.

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VibrantRx Member & Provider Services will be able to answer questions on your 2019 benefits **beginning October 15 at 1-844-826-3451**. TTY users should call 711. We are open 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. You can visit the VibrantRx web site **beginning October 15 at www.myVibrantRx.com/stateofaz**.



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By the end of October, you will receive a pre-enrollment kit with an opt-out letter. You don't need to do anything. **You will be automatically enrolled in VibrantRx.** Remember, you will lose your medical coverage if you opt out of prescription drug coverage. Please talk to ADOA's Benefit Services Division before making any changes.

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In November, watch your mail for a new VibrantRx Welcome Kit and prescription ID card. Please do not throw these away! Read your new plan materials carefully and make a note of any changes. Ask questions if you need more details. **Start using your VibrantRx ID card beginning January 1, 2019.**

Please continue to use your current Medicare GenerationRx prescription ID card through December 31, 2018.
