



# Tobacco Cessation Drug Coverage Information

As an employee or retiree of the State of Arizona, certain smoking cessation medications are available through the Tobacco Cessation Program at no cost to you. In addition, completion of the Tobacco Cessation Program makes you eligible for 150 HIP points.

To obtain over-the-Counter or prescription medications listed below at \$0 copay, you can either:

**1 Enroll in the State Employee Tobacco Cessation Program by calling 844-866-3727.**

- \* Once enrolled, your clinical pharmacist through the program will work closely with you to determine an appropriate tobacco cessation therapy.
- \* A prescription request will then be sent to your primary care provider for approval.
- \* Approved therapies will be faxed to your preferred pharmacy for pick up by you.

Or

**2 Obtain the prescription from your prescriber and bring it to your pharmacy for filling.**
